**What You Receive:** Upon successful completion of the exam (a passing score is 75% or higher) you will receive in the mail or through your employer a ServSafe Certificate from the National Restaurant Association, issued through the State Partner, the Vermont Hospitality Council. Certificates are valid for five years.

**Why You Should Attend:** According to the National Restaurant Association, an outbreak of food-borne illness can cost a food service operation over \$75,000 in legal fees, medical claims, lost wages and sanitizing costs. A staff certified by the ServSafe program will protect an employer against these losses.

**About Your Instructor:** Brian Norder is Project Director of the Vermont Food Venture Center in Fairfax, and Product Development Specialist for the Northeast Center for Food Entrepreneurship at the University of Vermont. He works with a wide range of individuals needing assistance and training to start or expand food businesses. Brian draws on nearly 20 years of restaurant and resort management experience in addition to his current work in food science.
